The school, functioning within the Kerala Agricultural University campus, serves a diverse group of young learners. The new vehicle significantly improves accessibility and supports consistent school attendance.



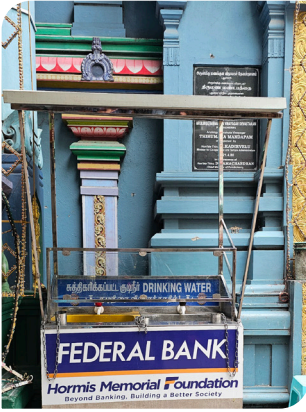

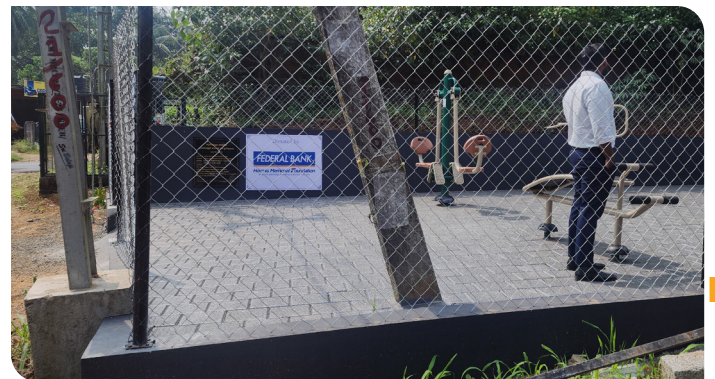
Kunnamkulam Municipality – Open Gym

District Hospital, Palakkad - Patient Support Equipment

A 160yearold institution, the hospital caters to over 2,200 outpatients and nearly 450 inpatients daily, including many from marginalized communities and tribal regions. The upgraded equipment plays a vital role in streamlining patient care.

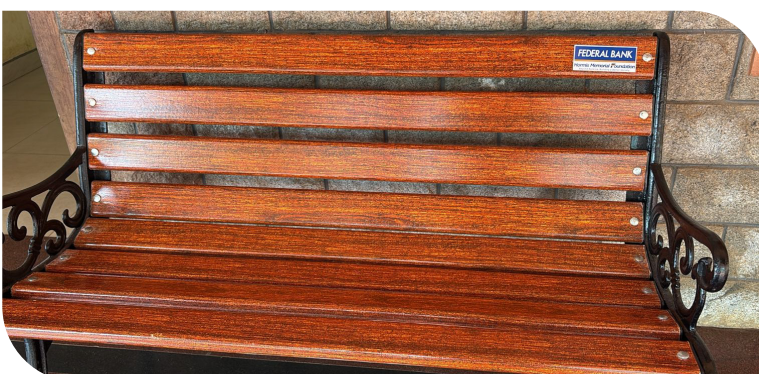


Babylog Ventilator for Newborn Care

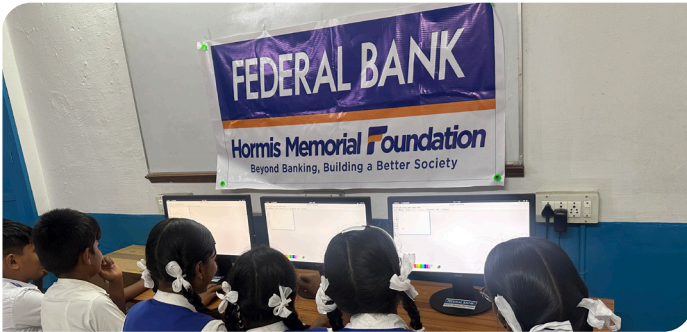
