A CSR Bulletin from Federal Bank

Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) has been an inherited and inbuilt element of Federal Bank's culture. Federal Bank Hormis Memorial Foundation, instituted as a public charitable trust in 1996, to perpetuate the fond memory of the Bank's founder late K. P. Hormis, is the principal arm in implementing various CSR programs/ projects of the Bank. The activities of the Trust are directed towards inculcating better knowledge and awareness in the field of banking through training programmes, focused seminars, and so on.

Federal Bank has been meaningfully contributing for the improvement of society to create a positive impact on the world through its sustainable practices, philanthropic endeavours, and community engagement. The Bank has approved a policy for Sustainable Development, which ensures that Bank's activities are conducive to sustainable social welfare. The CSR goals of the Bank align with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) established by the United Nations.



Kurali Municipal Council - Open Gym

Recognizing the growing importance of preventive healthcare and active lifestyles, the Bank extended CSR support to Kurali Municipal Council (Punjab) for the establishment of a free, open-access outdoor gym.

Located within the municipal limits, the facility promotes physical fitness among residents across age groups, including children, youth, working adults, and senior citizens.



Impact



Encourages daily physical activity for all age groups

Mercy Hospital, Thalayolaparambu – Eco Ambulance

To address the acute lack of affordable emergency medical transport in the Thalayolaparambu region, the Bank supported Mercy Hospital in procuring an Eco Ambulance through CSR funding. The hospital primarily serves economically vulnerable populations, many of whom face delays in accessing timely medical care due to transportation constraints.

Through this initiative, the Bank has enabled faster emergency response and improved patient outcomes, particularly for underprivileged patients requiring urgent medical attention.



Impact



Reduces emergency response time in critical cases

Kunnamkulam Municipality - Setting-Up Open Gym

In alignment with the Government of India's Fit India Movement, the Bank partnered with Kunnamkulam Municipality to establish an open gym accessible to the public. The gym serves as a shared public asset, encouraging community engagement and healthy habits across demographics.



Impact



Promotes regular physical activity and lifestyle wellness

St. Mary's Hospital, Manarcadu – 1 Haemodialysis Machine

The Bank supported St. Mary's Hospital, Manarcadu, in procuring a haemodialysis machine to meet growing patient demand. Originating as a small dispensary in 1947, the hospital has evolved into a key healthcare institution for the rural population in and around Manarcadu, Kottayam district in Kerala. The support helps the hospital strengthen its treatment capacity and improve access to affordable dialysis care.



Impact



Enables 1,200–1,400 additional dialysis sessions per year

Nish-Chintha, Palakkad – Autism Sensory Room

The Bank extended CSR assistance to NishChintha, a registered NGO supporting individuals with developmental and intellectual disabilities, for setting up a sensory room for autistic students. Founded in 2014, the organisation focuses on empowerment, skill development, and independent living for children with special needs. The sensory room supports structured therapeutic learning and developmental progress.




Impact  Enhances sensory processing, focus, and emotional regulation

Eldho Mor Baselious Dialysis Centre – Sewage Treatment Plant

The Bank supported the procurement and installation of a Sewage Treatment Plant at Eldho Mor Baselious Dialysis Centre, operating under Koinonia Mission Hospital at Vengola, Kerala. The centre currently runs 34 dialysis machines, conducting approximately 68 dialysis sessions daily, and has completed over 62,000 sessions to date. The intervention strengthens environmental compliance and sustainable operations at the facility.



Impact  Approximately 68 dialysis sessions conducted per day

Ujjain Municipal Corporation - Garbage Collection Vehicle

To improve waste collection efficiency and sanitation, the Bank supported Ujjain Municipal Corporation through CSR funding for the procurement of a garbage collection vehicle. The initiative enhances municipal capacity to manage household waste and contributes to cleaner urban surroundings.



Impact



Covers 1,000+ households in designated wards

St. Arnold's Higher Secondary School, Indore – Basketball Pole

The Bank supported St. Arnold's Higher Secondary School in installing a basketball pole within the campus. Established in 1990, the school has grown from 90 students to around 4,000 students, offering a wide range of academic and co-curricular facilities. The initiative reinforces the Bank's emphasis on holistic education through sports and physical activity.



Impact



Encourages holistic student development beyond academics

Shri Shyam Mandir, Patna – Water Cooler

The Bank supported the installation of a water cooler at Shri Shyam Mandir premises to ensure access to safe drinking water for devotees and visitors. The facility enhances convenience and hygiene at the temple.

Ensures access to clean drinking water

Choondal Gramapanchayath – Installing Solar Streetlights

As part of promoting clean and renewable energy solutions, the Bank supported the installation of solar streetlights at Parannoor Chira Park under Choondal Gramapanchayath in Kerala. The initiative improves public lighting while reducing dependence on conventional energy sources.



Impact



Reduces carbon emissions and electricity costs

Reena Memorial Samrakshana Society - Setting Up Solar Plant

The Bank supported Reena Memorial Samrakshana Society, Kochi, in installing solar panels at its special school for differently-abled students. The initiative helps reduce operational electricity costs while promoting sustainable energy usage, particularly after the institution undertook major repair works following monsoon damage.



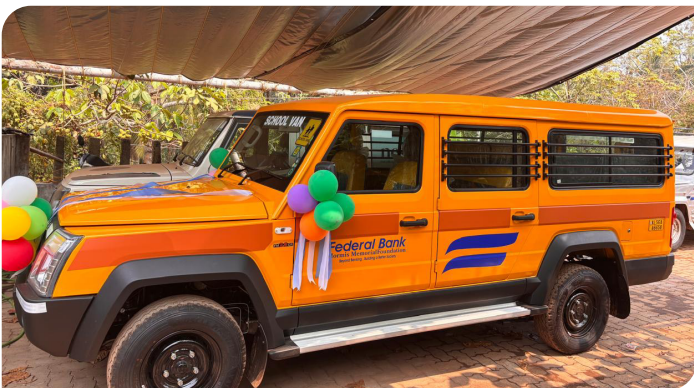
Impact

NEST International Academy and Research Centre – School Van

To overcome the challenge of inadequate and exhausting transportation faced by students—many of whom struggle with public transport or cannot afford private travel—the Bank extended CSR support through the Quilandy Branch for the procurement of a school van. The NEST International Academy and Research Centre (NIARC), Quilandy, Kozhikode, is a specialised institution functioning under the NEST Group, providing multidisciplinary rehabilitation, therapeutic interventions, and educational support for children with developmental and special needs.

Diocese of Tanjore Society - Purchasing School Bus

The Bank provided CSR support to the Diocese of Tanjore Society for purchasing a school bus for Nalanda Cathedral Nursery and Primary School. The initiative strengthens access to safe transportation for school children, particularly from underserved communities.



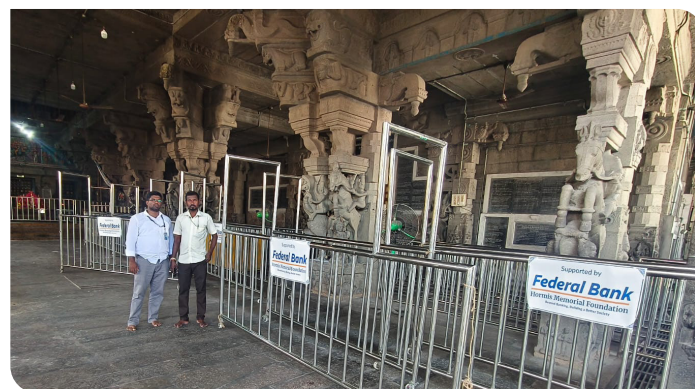
