Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) has been an inherited and inbuilt element of Federal Bank's culture. Federal Bank Hormis Memorial Foundation, instituted as a public charitable trust in 1996, to perpetuate the fond memory of the Bank's founder late K. P. Hormis, is the principal arm in implementing various CSR programs/ projects of the Bank. The activities of the Trust are directed towards inculcating better knowledge and awareness in the field of banking through training programmes, focused seminars, and so on.

Federal Bank has been meaningfully contributing for the improvement of society to create a positive impact on the world through its sustainable practices, philanthropic endeavours, and community engagement. The Bank has approved a policy for Sustainable Development, which ensures that Bank's activities are conducive to sustainable social welfare. The CSR goals of the Bank aligns with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) established by the United Nations.



Welfare Services Ernakulam (WSE) – Day Care Centre



As part of its commitment to promoting inclusive healthcare and community development, Federal Bank extended CSR support for the construction of the ground floor of a Skill Centre-cum-Day Care Facility for differently abled individuals established by Welfare Services Ernakulam (WSE).

The centre is designed as a comprehensive support facility, the centre houses therapy rooms, counselling rooms, training facilities, administrative offices, circulation spaces, and recreational areas.

The facility aims to empower differently abled individuals through therapeutic support, skill development, and social inclusion. The building was inaugurated on 20 February 2026 in the presence of distinguished guests and officials.

- Expected to benefit over 500 differently abled individuals annually
- Provides access to therapy, counselling, rehabilitation, and skill development services
- Promotes inclusion, independence, and community participation

CHC Purapuzha – Almirah for Medicine Storage



Federal Bank supported the Health & Wellness Centre under CHC Purapuzha by funding the purchase of an almirah for medicine storage, strengthening healthcare infrastructure at the grassroots level.

CHC Purapuzha is a key government healthcare institution serving patients across Idukki district. The newly provided almirah with glass doors, facilitates safe and systematic storage of medicines, enabling better inventory management and efficient dispensing of essential drugs.

Through this intervention, Federal Bank has contributed towards improving the operational efficiency of a public healthcare facility serving the local community.

Federal Bank supported Kulathupuzha Grama Panchayat for the distribution of school kits to students from economically disadvantaged families.

The initiative provides essential study materials to students from Classes I to XII belonging to families identified under the Panchayat's extreme poverty category. By easing the financial burden on parents and ensuring access to educational resources, the project contributes towards improving learning opportunities for vulnerable students.

Al-Huda English Senior Secondary School, Alappuzha – Interactive Panel

As part of its efforts to promote digital learning and educational excellence, Federal Bank supported the installation of an Interactive Panel Board at Al-Huda English Senior Secondary School, Alappuzha.

Managed by the Ideal Welfare Trust, the CBSE-affiliated institution serves approximately 1,480 students and is committed to providing quality education. The school also extends free education to students from economically weaker sections, reflecting its inclusive approach to learning.

The interactive panel will enhance classroom engagement, improve teaching effectiveness, and provide students with greater exposure to technology-enabled learning.

- Strengthens classroom engagement and learning outcomes

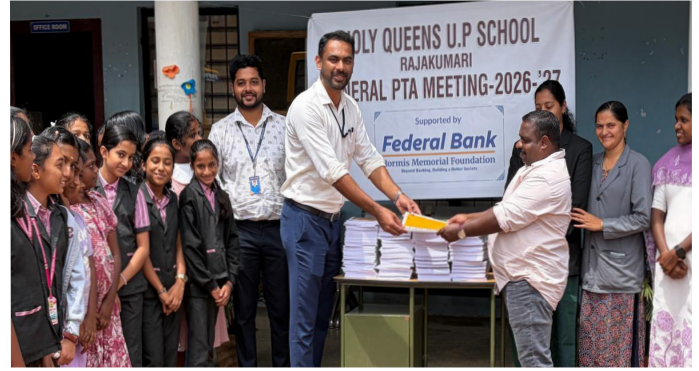
Holy Queen's U.P. School – Distribution of Notebooks



Federal Bank supported Holy Queen's U.P. School in providing notebooks to students from economically weaker backgrounds, reinforcing its commitment to inclusive education.

The government-aided institution, functioning under the Corporate Educational Agency of the Idukki Diocese, serves more than 350 students, many of whom belong to rural and socially disadvantaged communities.

By providing essential learning materials, the Bank's intervention helps reduce educational barriers and supports uninterrupted learning.

Nirmal Jyoti Public School, Pala – Water Purifier & Water Dispenser



With CSR support from Federal Bank, Nirmal Jyoti Public School established a safe drinking water facility through the installation of a water purifier and water dispenser.

The CBSE-affiliated school, established in 2004, caters to nearly 250 students and is supported by 24 teaching and 2 non-teaching staff members. The project ensures the availability of clean and safe drinking water within the campus, creating a healthier environment for students and staff.

Arulmigu Murugan Temple, Cholaimalai – RO Water Dispenser



Federal Bank supported the installation of an RO water dispenser at Arulmigu Murugan Temple, Alagarkovil, strengthening access to safe drinking water for devotees.

Situated in Madurai, the temple attracts lakhs of pilgrims annually from across Tamil Nadu and beyond. During peak pilgrimage periods and summer months, access to clean drinking water becomes essential for visitor welfare. The Bank's support enables the temple to provide safe drinking water to devotees, including senior citizens, children, and travellers.

Divyadarshan Sisu Mandir, Angul – Ceiling Fans



Federal Bank supported Divyadarshan Sisu Mandir, Angul, by funding the installation of 15 ceiling fans, helping create a comfortable learning environment for students.

The school serves nearly 800 students, predominantly from lower and middle-income families, and provides free education to around 25% of its students.

The Bank's assistance has helped improve classroom conditions, particularly during periods of high summer temperatures, enabling students to learn in a more comfortable environment.

Continuing its efforts to strengthen digital education infrastructure, Federal Bank supported Delhi Mar Thoma Public School in procuring two 65-inch Interactive Smart Boards.

Managed by the Mar Thoma Church, the CBSE-affiliated institution is recognised for its commitment to academic excellence and holistic student development. The smart boards will facilitate interactive teaching methodologies, improve student engagement, and support technology-enabled learning across classrooms.

Through this initiative, Federal Bank has contributed towards creating a modern and future-ready learning environment for students.

Deivamatha Church, Rajakumari – Water Purifier

Federal Bank supported the installation of a water purification system at Deivamatha Church, Rajakumari, ensuring access to safe drinking water for pilgrims and visitors.

One of the major pilgrimage centres in Idukki district, the church attracts a large number of devotees throughout the year. Recognizing the importance of safe drinking water in public spaces, the Bank's support enabled the church to provide clean and hygienic drinking water to visitors.

Taluk Hospital, Nadapuram – Television for Public Health Awareness



Federal Bank extended CSR support to Taluk Hospital, Nadapuram, for the installation of a television system aimed at strengthening public health awareness initiatives within the hospital.

The television will be used to display educational content on emerging diseases, preventive healthcare, vaccination programmes, government health schemes, and other important public health messages. The initiative seeks to improve health literacy among patients and visitors while encouraging informed healthcare decisions.

Reaffirming its commitment to sustainable development and tribal empowerment, Federal Bank supported the installation of two 10 kW solar power systems for tribal cooperative societies in Attappady.

The initiative benefits the Attappady Cooperative Farming Society (ACFS), Varadimala, and the Vattalakki Cooperative Farming Society (VCFS), both of which play a vital role in improving livelihoods among tribal communities through agriculture and micro-enterprises. The project was implemented in coordination with the Tribal Welfare Department, Government of Kerala, and the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India.

The Bank's support enabled the installation of an on-grid solar system at VCFS and an off-grid solar system at ACFS, helping reduce electricity costs and promote environmentally sustainable operations.
